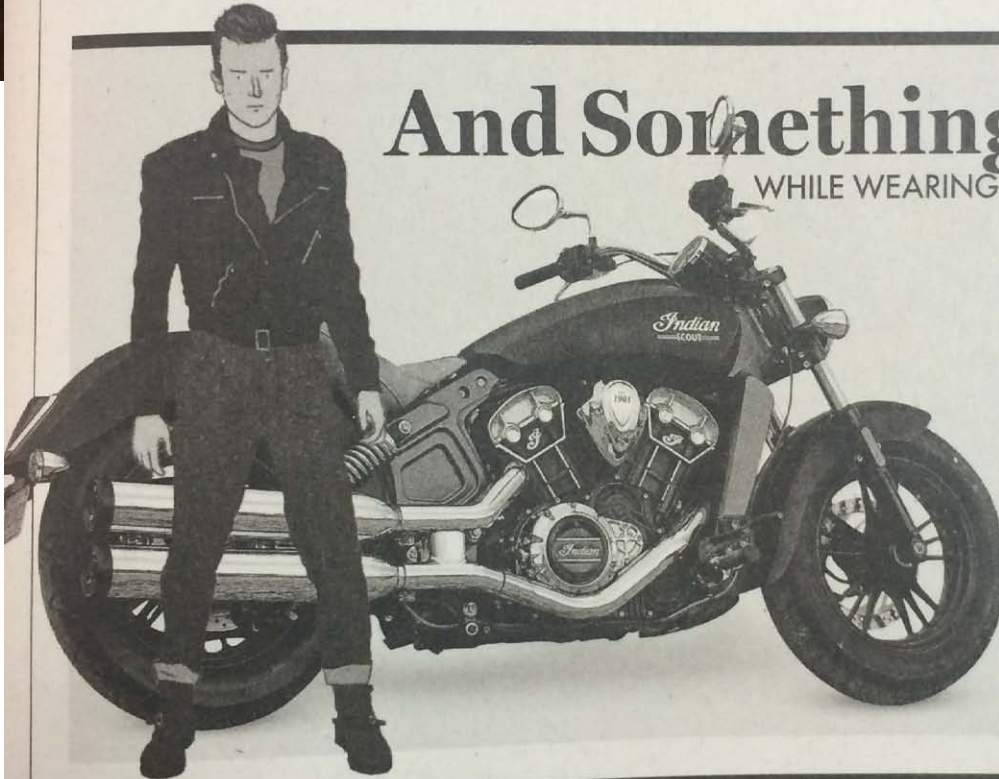

Please, take a moment to look at this machine. Not only is the 2015 Indian Scout (\$10,999; indianmotorcycles.com) beautiful, it's also an affordable, accessible homage to the popular Indian. The bike is light and maneuverable—558 pounds, compared with the beastlier 778-pound Indian Chief—but still packs a mighty 100-hp V-twin engine. If you're riding this, no one will think you're a beginner or that you're having a midlife crisis.
